The Municipality of Prespes is going to organize the Kick-Off Meeting of 'SmartWaterSave' project in the framework of the INTERREG IPA CBC Programme "Greece – The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia 2014-2020".

The 'SmartWaterSave' Kick-Off Meeting will be held on Friday, 19th of October 2018, at Prespes City Hall, Lemos – Prespes, Greece and it actually initiates the implementation of the 'SmartWaterSave' European project, where the Municipality of Prespes acts as the Lead Partner.

The Kick-Off Meeting of the project entitled 'A real time monitoring and leakage detection and reduction system in water distribution networks' (SmartWaterSave), will be held with the confirmed participation of representatives of the following organizations:

The aim of the SmartWaterSave project is to introduce an innovative technical methodology based on the idea of a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition system (SCADA), using real-time flow and pressure monitoring sensors, and therefore to promote a cost-effective approach for achieving a significant reduction in water leakage. The effective water pressure management is expected to reduce the risk of burst pipes and extend pipes service life.
